Members made additional recommendations at the meeting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Move the proposed RFP process for 2021 up, with RFPs released in January rather than March 2020. - Develop a way to track our best recruitment opportunities. - Automate this process as much as possible. - Consider promoting carpooling. - Collect mobile phone numbers so people can receive updates via text. - Add animal safety to the volunteer training. - Clarify the different roles of count team members. <p>The proposed 2021 timeline will be updated and shared with members at a future meeting.</p> <p>The training video will be shared electronically.</p>
