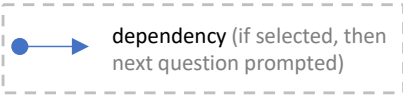


# HMIS: Gender & Orientation



## Gender Assigned at Birth:

The assignment made at birth by a physician or other medical professional's based on perception of external anatomy

**Gender assigned at birth**

- Female
- Intersex
- Male
- Client doesn't know

## Gender [Identity] :

*\*HUD's "Gender" field – cannot be altered*

Attitudes, feelings, characteristics, and behaviors that a given culture or society associates with being man, woman, or other and that are often labeled as "masculine" or "feminine."

Here, "Female" and "Male" refer to cisgender Female/Male (where assigned gender = identity gender)

**Gender Identity \* :**

- Female
- Male
- Trans Female (MTF or Male to Female)
- Trans Male (FTM or Female to Male)
- Gender Non-Conforming (i.e. not exclusively male or female)
- Client doesn't know
- Client refused
- Data not collected

## Sexual Orientation:

The emotional, romantic, and physical feelings of attraction - usually-over a period of time (some people do not experience primary attraction to anyone)
