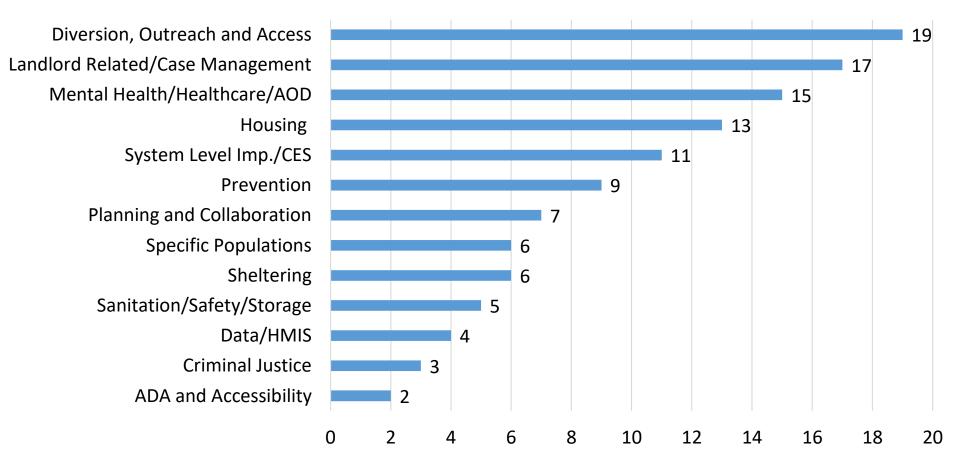

- Housing
 - NPLH PSH, City and County SB 2 Funding
- Behavioral Health Reforms
- System Level Improvements/Coordinated Entry Redesign
 - Developing standards for shelter, re-housing, outreach, case management
 - System mapping, gaps analysis, coordinated entry redesign & implementation funded with CESH (\$2.1m)
- Planning and Collaboration
 - Funded with CESH
 - Collaborative Data Dashboards
 - County Homeless Plan activities

Youth Process for HHAP Funding

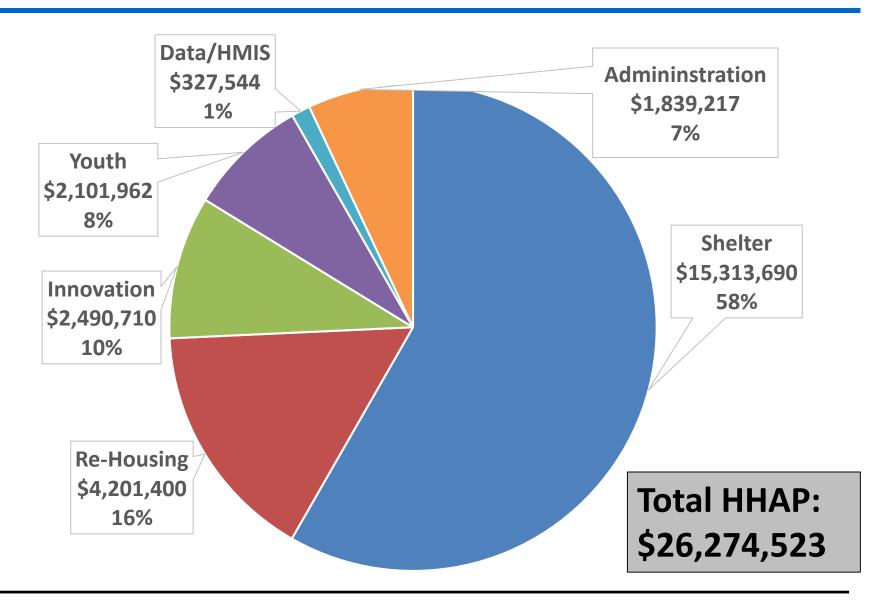
- Homeless Youth Task Force developed a project recommendation with the Youth Advisory Board (YAB) in December.
