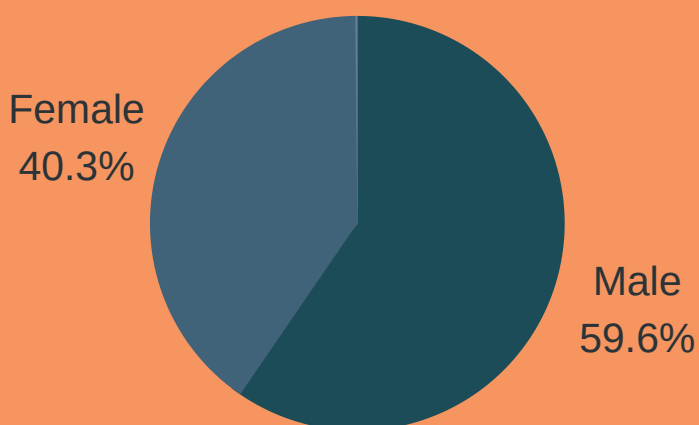

This is a demographic breakdown of 633 people served by the COVID-19 Temporary Shelter System isolation/quarantine units.

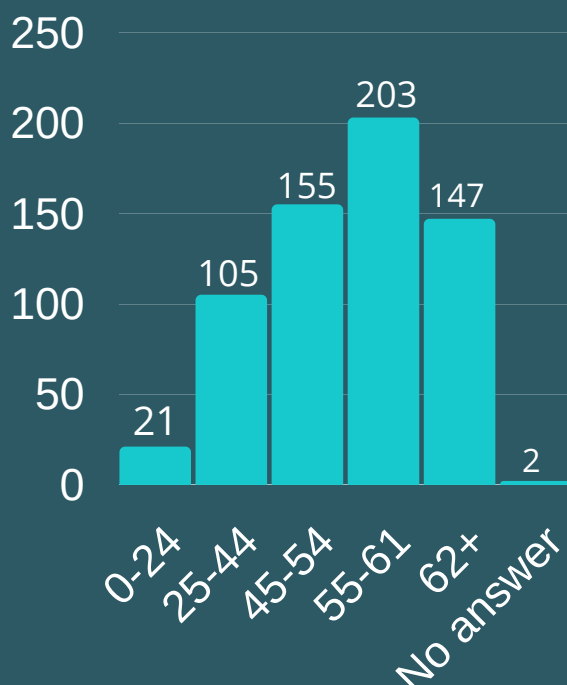

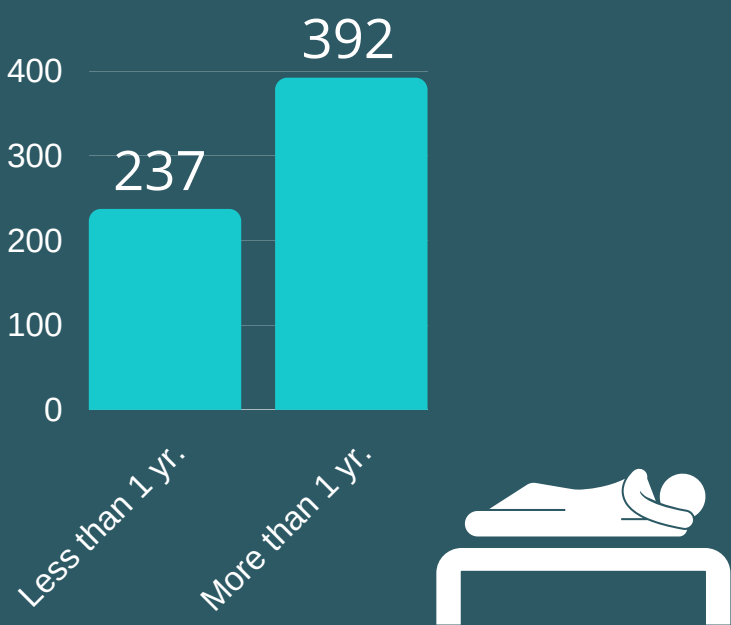

AGE

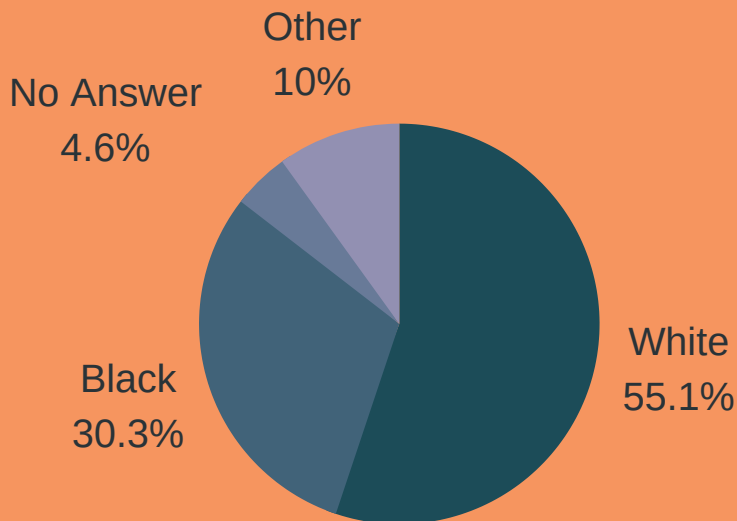


TIME SPENT HOMELESS

Adults and Head of Household

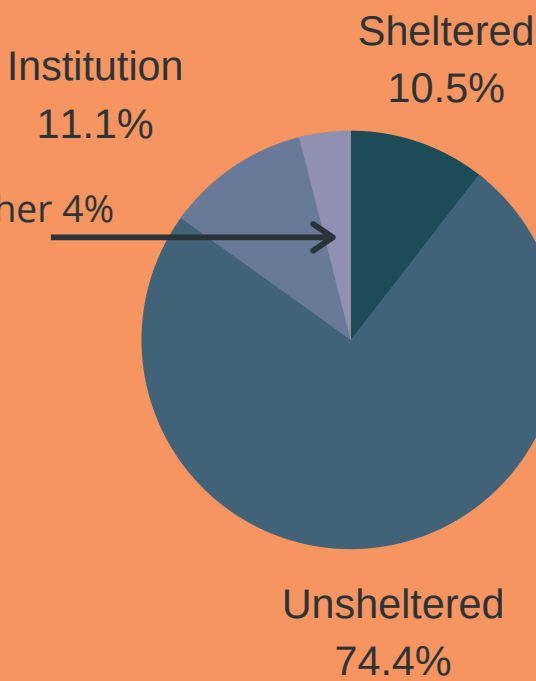

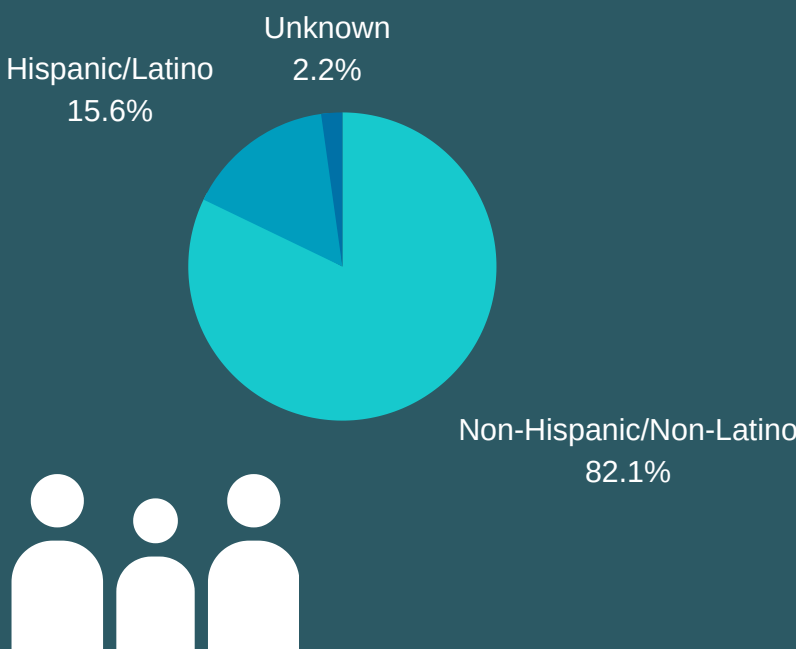
