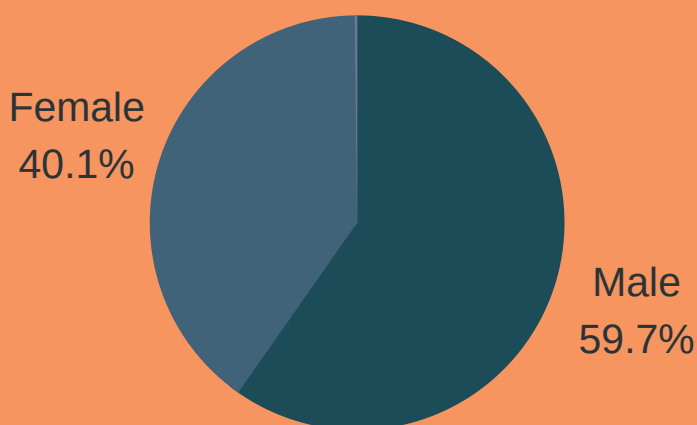
Demographic Report

This is a demographic breakdown of 1,088 people served by the COVID-19 Temporary Shelter System isolation/quarantine units.

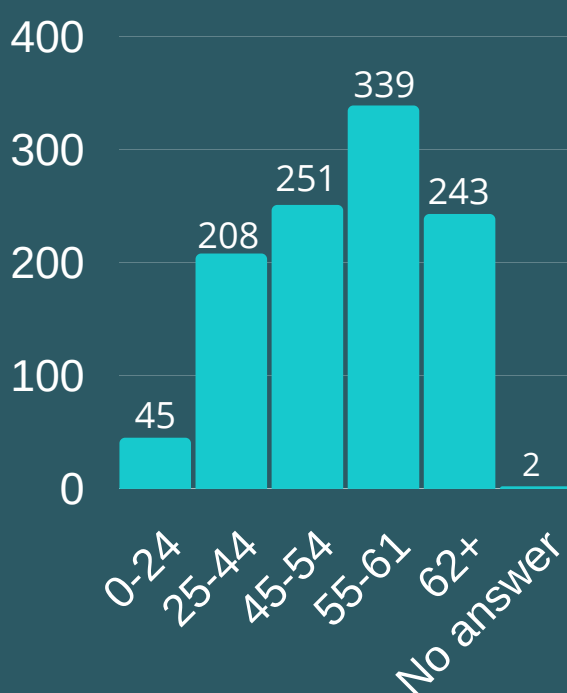
GENDER

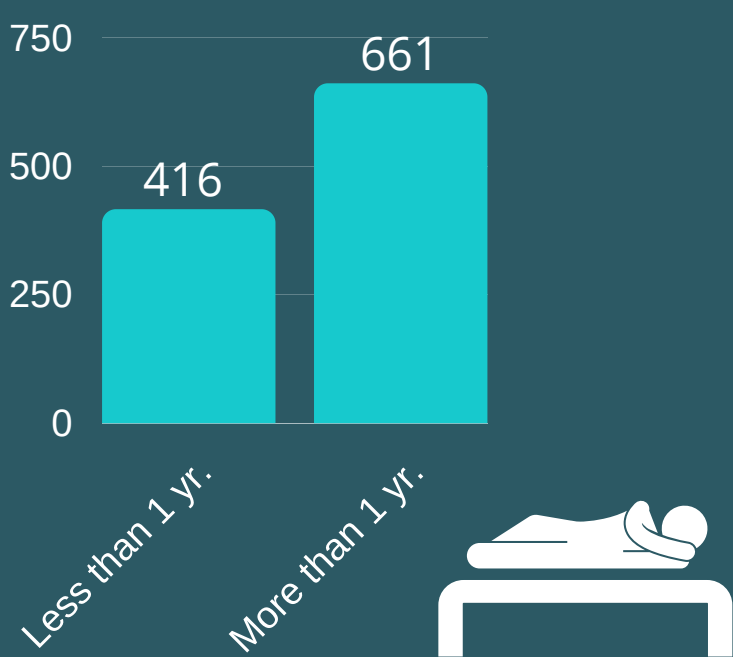

AGE

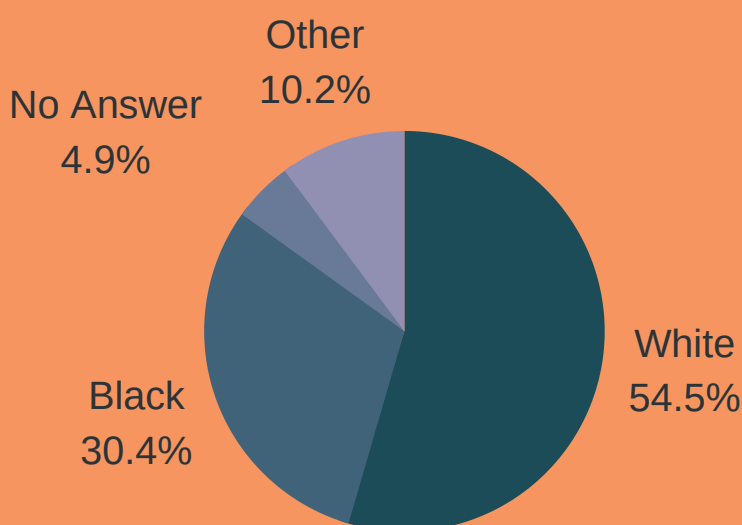


TIME SPENT HOMELESS

Adults and Head of Household

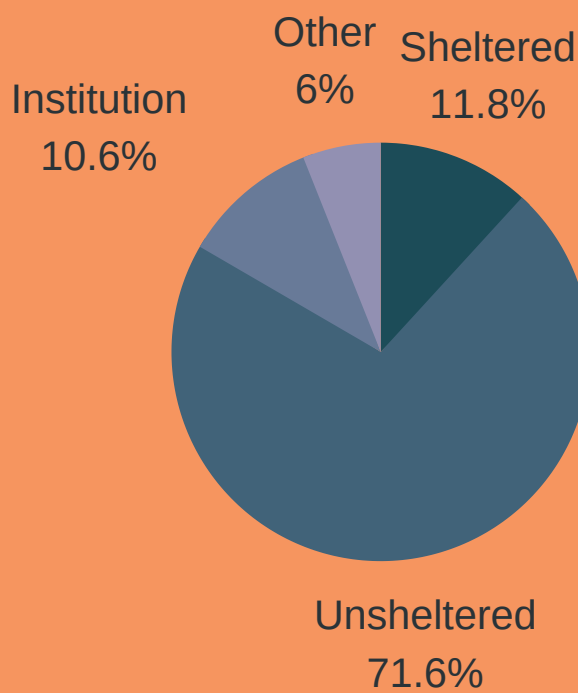

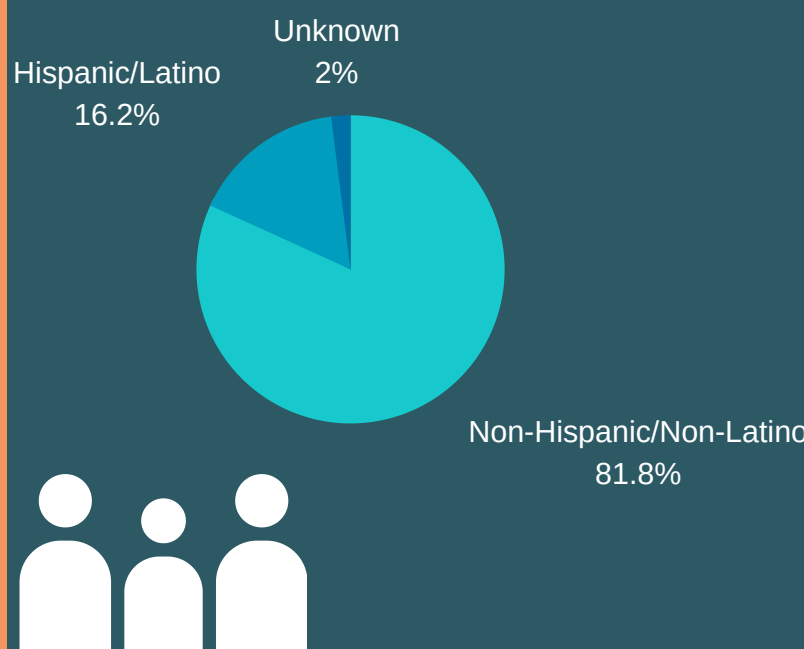
