Agenda Item - Groups Discussion


What does Sacramento really need? Below is a summary of ideas discussed:

- Housing:
 - Non-Congregate Beds (Current Inventory and increasing inventory)
 - Under 18 housing
 - DV youth specific housing
 - ADA Accessible Beds (Current Inventory and increasing inventory)
 - Family Beds (How does bed usage work in multi person families?)
 - What about for youth under 18 that are parenting?
 - TH-RRH (With flexible wraparound services in TH programming)
 - RRH/PSH and Prevention
 - More supportive RRH to mimic TLP approach
- Navigators:
 - Cross System Navigators to support with (Child Welfare, Juvenile Justice/Corrections, Healthcare, etc)
 - Housing Navigators to support with documentation (including \$ to acquire documents)
 - Youth Mailbox/Address for receiving documents
 - Navigators for Under 18 and transition to 25 and beyond
 - Navigators for college students
- Hiring providers with lived experience (in multi-level positions/beyond just direct service)

- Staff should also be paid a living wage
- Staff should have low
- Process for tracking referrals and placements outside of HMIS (either include agencies into HMIS or add "other" or "fill in" option for placement)
- Master leas controlled units
- Additional community supports
- Life Skills
- Alchol and other Drug resources
- Number and Percent of Housing Inventory Being Used (Goal to keep at 90% or above)
- Mental Health/Trauma Informed/ De-escalation trained providers with livable wages
- "Flexible" Permanent Housing Criteria
 - Minimal Documentation Requirements
- *Noticed that an increase of time in housing programming with support increased the likelihood and longevity of permanency/housing stability*
