1. The Emergency Operations Center is activating today. They will respond to disasters and mobilize recovery efforts in our area.

- 2. Free RT rides will be extended through Saturday to warming centers & shelters.
- 3. Please call 211 for referrals for weather respite and temporary shelter. The County is working to increase capacity through the weekend.
- 4. Weather respite through the City is extended through Saturday morning (8am) and there is expanded capacity at the Outreach and Engagement Center.
- 5. The motel voucher program has limited capacity through partnering motels. Sac Covered, Sacramento Self Help Housing and HEART are able to make referrals, if there is availability.
