AGENICES

Community organizations - called Agencies - sign contracts to access our HMIS.



Once in the system, they set up
Programs or Projects (these words are
used interchangeably within Clarity).
These programs/projects are created
under a specific agency and are generally
only accessible to employees of that
agency.



If an agency is partnering with another agency on a specific program, they may have a Partnership Agency, where a joint program is created that employees from both agencies can access.

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To grant access for individual HMIS End Users, a participating agency must request system access for their employees.



The agency will determine which Access Level they need based on the kind of work they are doing in the system and their level of responsibility in the agency.



If the agency is collaborating on a project in a partnership agency, they may ask for their employee to be granted Additional Agency Access, so they can log into multiple agencies to complete their work.

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Users enter Services into client profiles to document service.

Users enroll clients into their agency's programs.

Depending on their level of access, users may be able to run Reports that provide insight into the activity happening in their program.
