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Michele shared details:

- New Community Housing and Friendship Housing will be closing by September 2024.
- With this closure, the CAS Housing team will need to process approximately 130+ transfers to other PSH and PH openings within the Coordinated Access System to ensure that the residents in New Community and Friendship Housing do not return to homelessness. Effective 1/16/2024, Single Adult Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) and Permanent Housing (PH) referrals will be paused to prioritize these transfers.
- Based on the frequency of our housing openings, our team is anticipating that this transfer process will take up to nine months.
- The CAS Housing team will continue to process PSH, RRH and PH referrals for family openings within CAS as they become available.
