| | 6 | Intentional Homicides | Send to the admissions review committee for felony convictions within previous 3 years. |
| | 7 | Manslaughter | Send to the admissions review committee for felony convictions within previous 3 years. |
| | 8 | Kidnapping and Abduction | Send to the admissions review committee for felony convictions within previous 3 years. |
| | 9 | Sex offenses - forcible | Send to the admissions review committee for all felony and misdemeanor convictions within previous 3 years. Mandatory lifetime ban for any registered sex offender |
| | 10 | Sex offenses – non-forcible | Send to the admissions review committee for all felony and misdemeanor convictions within previous 3 years. Mandatory lifetime ban for any registered sex offender |
| | 11 | Stalking | Send to the admissions review committee for felony convictions within previous 3 years. |

| Crimes Against Property | 12 | Arson-related offenses | Send to the admissions review committee for felony convictions within previous 3 years. |
| | 13 | Burglary/Breaking and Entering-related offenses | Send to the admissions review committee for all felony Burglary convictions within previous 3 years |
| | 14 | Fraud | Send to the admissions review committee for felony convictions within previous 3 years |

| Crimes Against Society | 16 | Drug offenses – Possession | Send to the admissions review committee for all felony convictions within previous 3 years |
| | 17 | Drug offenses - Manufacture, Distribution, or Possession with Intent to Distribute | Send to the admissions review committee for all felony and misdemeanor convictions within previous 3 years. Mandatory lifetime ban for being convicted of manufacturing or producing methamphetamine on the premises of federally assisted housing. |
| | 18 | Driving under the influence-related offenses | Send to the admissions review committee for all felony and misdemeanor convictions. Must have at least two convictions within previous 18 months. |
| | 19 | Weapons offenses (other than use of a firearm) | Send to the admissions review committee for all felony convictions within previous 3 years if the conviction is for a violent offense. |

| | 22 | Debts owed to a federally assisted housing program | Sacramento Housing will deny housing assistance to any family still owing a debt to any federally housing program. Sacramento Housing will offer the client a 30 day window to repay the debt and provide proof of the debt repayment. |
